Atropine - indications:

Atropine	Anticholinergic	 Vagally mediated bradycardia Primary AV block Post MI bradycardia (more effective first 24 hours) Bradycardia not responsive to O2 Rx, AW support, and epinephrine Prevention of bradycardia during endotracheal intubation for children <1 year of age, children 1-5 years of age receiving succinylcholine, and children over 5 years of age receiving a second dose of succinylcholine Organophosphate poisoning adjuvant use with anticholinesterases (eg, edrophonium, neostigmine) to decrease their side effects during reversal of neuromuscular blockade Off label for stress echo studies
