

Atropine - indications:

Drug	Mechanism of action	Indications
Atropine	Anticholinergic	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Vagally mediated bradycardia2. Primary AV block3. Post MI bradycardia (more effective first 24 hours)4. Bradycardia not responsive to O2 Rx, AW support, and epinephrine5. Prevention of bradycardia during endotracheal intubation for children <1 year of age, children 1-5 years of age receiving succinylcholine, and children over 5 years of age receiving a second dose of succinylcholine6. Organophosphate poisoning7. adjuvant use with anticholinesterases (eg, edrophonium, neostigmine) to decrease their side effects during reversal of neuromuscular blockade8. Off label for stress echo studies
