ICP monitoring: Indications

The purpose of monitoring ICP is to improve the clinician's ability to maintain adequate CPP and oxygenation.

Indications for ICP include:

- 1. Suspected to be at risk for elevated ICP (closed head injury)
- 2. Comatose (Glasgow Coma Scale <8)
- 3. Diagnosed with a process that merits aggressive medical care (TBI, CNS infections, Ischemic stroke, neoplasm, vasculitis, hydrocephalus, Idiopathic intracranial hypertension (pseudotumor cerebri)
